THE NICHE

Abeja (Spanish for Bee) founders Ken and Ginger Harrison came to Walla Walla Valley in the late 1990s in search of land suitable for planting world class Cabernet Sauvignon. They discovered an extraordinary historic farmstead that captured their hearts and sparked their imagination. They preserved the property's rich heritage while creating a one-of-a-kind Walla Walla wine country destination by renovating its historic outbuildings while also planting top quality vineyards. Today, winemakers Dan Wampfler & Amy Alvarez-Wampfler create handcrafted wines that are the result of meticulous viticultural practices; customized small lot fermentation and aging; and selective blending. Abeja's wines are old world in style with that stamp of pure, lush Washington fruit.

TOP SKUS

Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley

Dense aromas of black stone fruits, fragrant allspice and berry are captivating and generous on the nose. A surge of ripe plum defines the mouth-filling entry yet shows restraint in a well-crafted palate which displays grip and structure. Finally, layers of bright cherry, sage, and clove come into focus and leading into a lasting, memorable finish.

Chardonnay Washington State

Brilliant in color with a pale-yellow hue, the Washington Chardonnay offers a generous nose of apple blossoms, nutmeg and lemon curd. Melon and white peach coat the palate, followed by notes of quince and golden apple that linger on a vibrant, mouthwatering finish.

Merlot Columbia Valley

A fresh nose brimming with crushed berries and black cardamom instantly lures and continues throughout. The body is round and well-structured with fine tannins revealing accents of cocoa, Oolong tea and strawberry preserves leading into a decadent finish.

Rosé of Sangiovese

An intentional rosé from pruning to picking with racy acid and explosive strawberry and cherry fruit. Bright pink color resulting from a blend of direct press mechanically harvested fruit & cold soaked hand-harvested fruit.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Blended from vineyards in White Bluffs, Yakima and Columbia Valley, gentle tannin extraction and 12+ barrel months aging in European oak upright tanks results in a fruit-led, round, and supple style.

Merlot

Blended from vineyards in Yakima and Columbia Valleys this fragrant red with notes of plum and dark berries ages 16 months in barrel resulting in supple tannins, and subtle notes of toasted oak. 80% Merlot with small amounts of Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Petit Verdot to add complexity.

Chardonnay

Ferments predominantly in neutral oak with the balance cool fermented in stainless steel resulting in beautiful balance and bright fruit intensity. Quintessential white for seafood pairing with bright citrus notes layered with apple and pear fruit with subtle hints of butterscotch.

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Upon his retirement from the NFL in 2007, Drew Bledsoe “doubled back” to his hometown of Walla Walla, Washington to realize a long-held dream. Drew and his wife, Maura, purchased a piece of property on the southern edge of the Walla Walla Valley AVA and subsequently launched Doubleback as an estate focused winery with the goal of crafting America’s best Cabernet Sauvignon in an elegant, true to varietal way. Drew had long been planning for this moment during his years playing football and success came immediately as the very first vintage earned a spot in Wine Spectator’s Top 100 List.

Doubleback Cabernet Sauvignon, Walla Walla Valley

Saturated dark ruby. Ultra-sexy, juicy, ripe raspberry, with notes of vanilla and toasty oak. Rich, velvety and an absolutely intense mid-palate weight that is so pleasing. Cocoa, baking spices, and a lengthy, mouthwatering finish with soft and rich tannin.

Bledsoe Family Winery Cabernet Sauvignon, Walla Walla Valley

With dark ruby in the glass, it opens up aromatically in the same fashion. Dark fruits like blackberry and Bing Cherry, followed up by graphite, wood shavings, and baking spice. Ultra-balanced with long, fine-grained tannins and great acidity.

Bledsoe McDaniels Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley

Hails from two top growing regions, Ribbon Ridge and Eola-Amity Hills. Screams of fresh blueberries, black tea, and hints of forest floor and fennel seed. Soft, chewy, sweet tannins and great acid all build to a large and long finish.

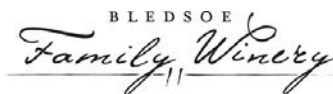

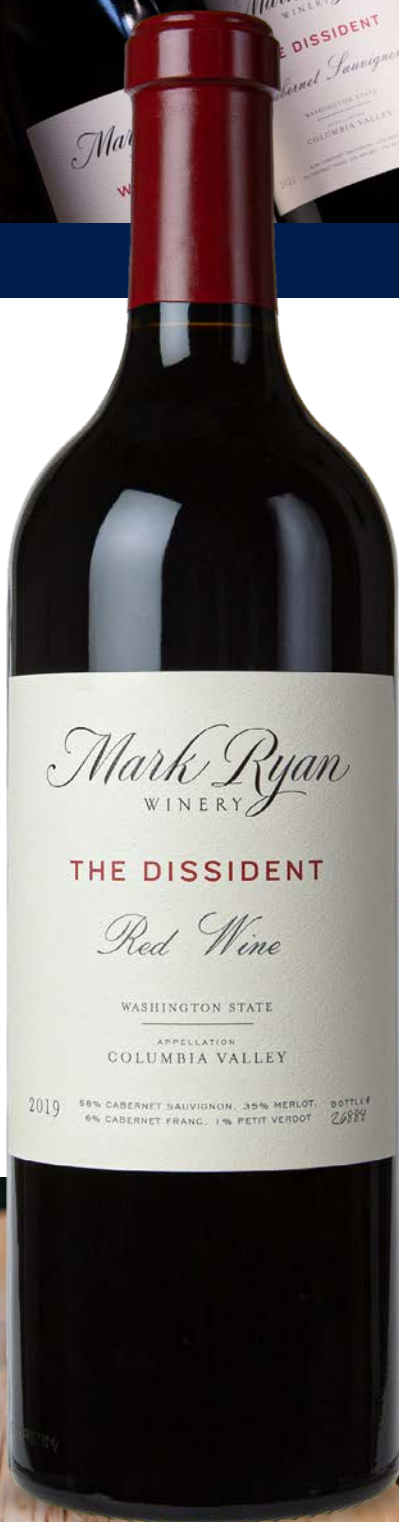

Blend of Sangiovese and Syrah, a dry, fruit-forward rosé with bright strawberry and peach aromatics, a lush ripeness, and lingering floral finish. Part of the Underground Wine Project portfolio, this cult favorite is playful and lively.

Board Track Racer "The Vincent" Chardonnay

Almost entirely fermented in stainless steel with a touch of barrel fermentation to add complexity, depth and richness. Enticing aromas of granny smith apple and ripe pear aromas with a well-balanced palate of stone fruit flavors, vibrant acidity and lingering, luscious mouthfeel.

Board Track Racer Cabernet Sauvignon

Merlot and Petit Verdot are added to the blend to add complexity and balance. Black currant and dark plum with vanilla and tobacco notes. Full bodied and powerful with well-rounded tannins and plump fruit.

Mark Ryan "The Dissident"

83% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot, 3% Cabernet Franc, 2% Petit Verdot. Limited production (6,096 cases) and highly rated from some of Washington State's finest vineyards (Quintessence, Red Willow, Phinny Hill). Ages 18 months in 37% new French oak. Rich dark fruit, violets, and graphite aromas with plush fine tannins and a lengthy finish.

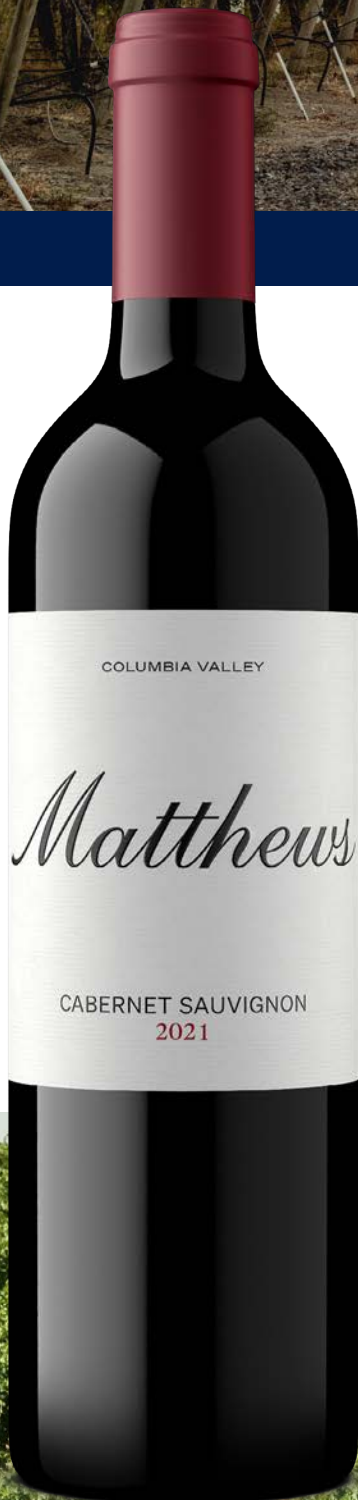

TOP SKUS

Sauvignon Blanc

Aged mostly in stainless steel with a small portion of neutral oak. The wine had some lees stirring while in tank. Honeysuckle and green papaya notes combine with shades of mango and cantaloupe. The palate is rich and viscous with a sensational sense of mouthfeel and smooth texture. This is heady and delicious Sauvignon Blanc.

Cuvee Red Blend

Majority Merlot with the balance Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon, fruit from several small vineyards, namely Conner Lee vineyard, as well as key sites in the White Bluffs and Royal Slope AVAs. This wine truly represents the broad flavor and aromatic expressions of a merlot-dominant blend from the diverse terroirs of Washington State.

Claret

Every bit outstanding the 2021 Claret combines Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot with smaller parts Malbec and Petit Verdot. Chocolate and espresso grounds mark the nose alongside shades of huckleberry and dried herbs. The palate is soft and well-balanced with a smooth texture. Showing salty and earthy undertones, this is a fantastic showing that displays each varietal working in seamless motion.

Cabernet Sauvignon

This wine represents the broad flavor & aromatic expressions of Cabernet Sauvignon from the diverse terroirs of Washington State. Precise and expressive, with handsome flavors of blackberry, bay leaf and espresso that build richness and structure toward refined tannins.

Novelty Hill and Januik are two independent wineries that share a destination tasting room and state-of-the-art winery under the direction of Mike Januik, one of Washington State's most acclaimed winemakers. The Novelty Hill and Januik partnership began in 2000, shortly after Mike began consulting on the planting of the Alberg family's Stillwater Creek Vineyard on the Royal Slope of the Frenchman Hills in Washington State's Columbia Valley. Though an uncharted growing region at the time, Mike liked what the site offered and was intrigued by the Albergs' interest in planting a diverse selection of clones. He encouraged the family to consider making wine from the site; they agreed, provided Mike serve as winemaker. Novelty Hill was born.

TOP SKUS – Novelty Hill

Chardonnay Stillwater Creek Vineyard

A balanced, elegant wine. Crisp apple, juicy pear, a streak of citrus and a hint of baking spice blend seamlessly across a rich, round mid-palate. The finish is long and lush, leaving a smooth, graceful impression.

Merlot Columbia Valley

Polished and focused, with cocoa, red currant and black cherry aromas and flavors stretching across a supple mid-palate. The wine's refined tannins linger on a long, expressive finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley

Rich and concentrated, this full-bodied, aromatic Cabernet Sauvignon offers expressive layers of ripe plum, black currant and wild blackberries. A textured, mouth-filling wine true to its varietal character with a balanced, refined finish.

Syrah Columbia Valley

A deep, ruby red wine. Layers of exotic spice, dark stone fruit and wild blackberry aromas and flavors gain focus across a firmly textured midpalate. Rich and mouth-filling, with refined tannins that linger on a dense, expressive finish.

TOP SKUS – Januik

Chardonnay

Rich and elegant, has hints of Meyer lemon, Asian pear, and green apple as well as a slight mineral quality. It has a rich creamy texture on the palate and a bright lengthy finish.

Merlot

This supple, medium-bodied Merlot shows layers of black cherry, boysenberry and plum notes in the nose that translate into fleshy black fruit and chocolate flavors in the mouth. Brimming with a tremendous amount of texture and length.

Cabernet Sauvignon

This supple, rich Cabernet Sauvignon is packed with currant and black cherry flavors as well as plum, chocolate and vanilla notes in the nose. Its texture is quite refined and shows great structure throughout the mouth, imparting a long, luxurious finish that was developed in part from the use of new French Oak barrels.

Andrew Januik Stone Cairn Red Mountain Red

This deep purple wine is overflowing withassis, black raspberry and chocolate notes. It is multi-layered and textured with flavors that range from spice to mocha and dark fruit. The finish is long and brimming with the bright acidity and supple tannins that are indicative of Red Mountain.

"Aromas of fresh apples and white talc, with a quiet underpinning of white flowers. On the palate there's a coiled sensibility to this wine, like it's lying in wait to spring out at you. This is buffered by a cool, creamy lusciousness that carries into a long finish."

"Deliciously layered aromas of black cherry and black raspberry lift out of the glass, followed by exotic spice notes and a dark, rich loamy quality. This wine is like satin in the mouth—so supple. It toes the line between ethereal and ponderous in the most delightful way."

"My first impression is of strawberries and cream, framed with floral notes, citrus zest, and an intriguing minerality. The palate is supple and juicy and provides a balanced framework. 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COOPER MOUNTAIN VINEYARDS

Cooper Mountain Vineyards took root in the Willamette Valley 45 years ago under the leadership of Dr. Bob Gross, a homeopathic doctor, and his wife Corinne. His goal was to make wines that best express the Northern Willamette valley – sunshine, cool nights, and fresh fruit that results in wines that are lively, but also show soul. When Cooper Mountain Vineyards got its start, there were just a handful of wine-makers in the Willamette Valley, and Cooper Mountain was a pioneer in biodynamic wine growing. Now in its second generation, Barbara Gross has led their focus on the future with growth to 200 acres of vineyards, including the addition of the iconic Chehalem Mountain vineyard to their estate, while continuing her father's strong bond to the land.

COOPER MOUNTAIN VINEYARDS

KEY SELLING POINTS

- **Pioneers:** Founded in 1978, Cooper Mountain was one of the first wave of wineries in the Willamette Valley and an early leader in biodynamic and organic winegrowing.

Fresh & inviting style of Pinot Noir with opportunity for by the glass and display programs. Overdelivers with estate vineyards, biodynamic farming and non-interventionist winemaking.

TOP SKUS

Dundee Hills Pinot Noir

Youthful and bright. On the nose, the wine is bursting with black cherry and ripe sour cherry tones, with hints of dried violets and lightly roasted coffee beans. The palate confirms the nose with added notes of fresh raspberry, cranberry, and a decidedly earthy touch.

“Laurène” Pinot Noir

Flagship Pinot Noir -100% Estate fruit. The energetic nose reveals notes of baked Rainier cherry and candied orange peel, with subtle sage and wild herb undertones. On the palate, blueberry notes intertwine with baking spice and anise, offering a complex and layered experience.

“Arthur” Chardonnay

Partial French oak, partial stainless-steel fermentation for best balance and expression. Fragrant nose of mandarin peel, vanilla blossoms, and honeysuckle. Nuanced flavors of lemongrass, white flowers, a hint of yuzu, and yellow plum all support the exquisite texture and well-defined structure.

The Campbell's goal has always been hand-crafted, Estate-grown cool climate wines that rival the best in the world. As a second-generation winemaker and a 5th generation Oregon farmer, Adam Campbell is proud to continue that tradition. He now oversees six vineyard sites with 380 acres planted. That's over 10 times the total acreage of all Oregon vineyards when Pat and Joe planted that very first vine in 1974.

TOP SKUS

Elk Cove Pinot Gris

With ripe pear, honey and citrus on the nose, this wine opens lush and juicy with white peach, lemon curd and honeydew melon leading to an elegant finish of lemongrass and slate.

Elk Cove Willamette Valley Pinot Noir

Raspberry and dark cherry lead into woodsy aromas of mushroom, violet and thyme. Full and very fruit-forward, the wine finishes long with cardamom and warm baking spices.

Pike Road Pinot Gris

A fruit-forward and vibrant example of Willamette Valley Pinot Gris.

Pike Road Pinot Noir

A dark-fruited and elegant Pinot Noir sourced from some of the top family-owned vineyards in the Willamette Valley.

In 1999, Eric Lemelson, an environmental lawyer, climate change activist, and LEED building specialist, crafted his first vintage to further his commitment to the environment, to the land, and to his community. Utilizing organic farming and gravity flow production, Lemelson crafts expressive Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris, Chardonnay and Riesling from estate vineyards throughout the Willamette Valley.

KEY SELLING POINTS

- **Sustainable & Organic:** Sustainability is at the core of Lemelson vineyards reflecting the values of owner Eric Lemelson, an environmental lawyer, climate change and energy policy activist and builder of high performance LEED buildings. All vineyards have been farmed organically since the beginning and certified by Oregon Tilth since 2004.
- **Fun Fact:** Eric's father, Jerome, was a prolific inventor and the propeller beanie emblem on Lemelson's corks and labels celebrates one of his first patents.
- **100% Estate:** Lemelson farms 5 estate vineyards from three AVA's (Yamhill Carlton, Chehalem Mountains, & Dundee Hills) offering an array of soil types and characteristics. This model, common in Burgundy, gives them full control to farm with precision and adds to the quality of their wines.
- **Innovation:** Lemelson's sophisticated, gravity-flow winery is particularly suited to gentle handling of Pinot Noir and continues the commitment to sustainability in the choice of local building materials and concrete caves.

TOP SKUS

Thea's Selection Pinot Noir

Mostly destemmed with a high proportion of whole berries. 30+ days on skins followed by aging for 15 months in 25% new French oak with the balance used French oak. Blend of their five organic, estate vineyards from three Willamette Valley AVA's- represents the varied soils and character of Willamette Valley. Indigenous yeast. Bottled unfinned & unfiltered.

Stermer Vineyard Pinot Noir

100% destemmed with a high proportion of whole berries. 30+ days on skins followed by aging for 15 months in 50% new French oak with the balance used French oak. Estate vineyard across from winery in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA – planted in '97 in marine sedimentary soils adding spice and earth to the cherry fruit. Indigenous yeast. Bottled unfinned & unfiltered.

Chardonnay

Barrel fermented and aged 14 months in 21% new French oak. Blend of Johnson and Chestnut Hill estate vineyards, both certified organic. Green apple, caramel, lemon and vanilla aromas with a rich texture and excellent acidity.

Tikka's Run Pinot Gris – focused markets

Fermented in 80% tank and 20% neutral oak barrels. Aged 6 months on the lees to build texture. Bright pear, Meyer lemon, and melon with ginger and white floral notes. 100% Chestnut Hill Vineyard – Jory volcanic soils in Chehalem Mountain at 1,000 ft of elevation to preserve natural acidity. 8/0 g/L residual sugar.

TOP SKUS

Eola Amity Pinot Noir

A cuvée selection from the estate's 35 blocks, which are handpicked, sorted and individually fermented. While Eola-Amity Hills Pinot Noirs are typically known for their structure and power, Véronique Drouhin emphasizes Roserock's elegant and refined qualities, making for a delicious and age worthy cuvée.

"Zéphirine" Pinot Noir

A barrel selection cuvée from the Roserock vineyard, and is a reference expression of the site. Zéphirine conveys purity and beauty, reflects winemaker Véronique Drouhin's dedication to elegance and finesse, and will age meaningfully for years to come. The name refers to the Zéphirine Drouhin variety of climbing rose, which is known for its fragrance and beauty.

Eola Amity Hills Chardonnay

Blend of three estate vineyards blocks in the cool Eola-Amity Hills AVA creating a wine defined by balance and precision. Partial French oak, partial stainless-steel fermentation for best balance and expression. A layered bouquet includes fragrant gardenia and perfumed honeysuckle, while acidity and nuanced stone fruit flavors energize the palate. Subtle minerality adds depth and refinement.
